New Check in Policy: A new manager means new challenges. Our new manager and new employees will have a learning curve to get to know everyone. To help with this, and to help them provide better service to everyone, it is now required that all golfers (members, and guests) check in at the clubhouse before playing. The employees will be entering every round played into our new digital tee sheet. Again, all golfers are now required to check in for every round played. This practice will be New Policy going forward and your participation is greatly appreciated.

Member database: In order to streamline this process and help our new manager we are asking you to please give us your email and cell phone number when you pay your membership dues. We will have everyone uploaded into the system so that Rhonda can put a name with a face right away. This will also allow us to let you know about events, rain outs, etc.

PROJECTS & UPGRADES

Renovations: Beginning in mid to late August we will be starting phase 3 of our course renovations. The course will remain open during this time with certain holes closed as the project progresses. Please look for a specific update meeting on the project in the near future where you can learn more about the very exciting improvements.

New Rental Fleet: For those of you who don't keep a cart on site we are excited to announce that we will be bringing in a new fleet of brand new 2025 Club Car golf carts. With this we plan to offer a season pass option for rental carts.

Cart Paths: We will be adding some concrete paths in high use and flood areas. We will also get some of the asphalt paths repaired or completely removed in other areas.

Clubhouse improvements: We are installing a new back bar and shelving behind the bar. There will be plenty of additional storage for more drink and merchandise options. There will also be a new larger TV centered in the cabinet.

Updated Course Maintenance Equipment: We are purchasing a used fairway mower that is coming off a lease at Meadowbrook in Rapid City. It is a low hours machine that they purchased new.

We also ordered a brand-new Toro greens mower. We expected it to arrive at the end of this year, however it is now scheduled to arrive before the season starts.

Also, we are purchasing a dedicated greens roller with the 2025 raffle proceeds. With the new greens mower and roller, we intend to continue to improve on the playing quality, speed, and consistency of our greens!

Flood Mitigation: We have been working with both a golf architect, and an engineering firm, to look at any viable solutions to course flooding. Most likely we cannot stop flooding, but we can possibly implement some changes to help lessen the impact. That is our long-term goal.
